POLMONT CHURCH: DITCH SECTION

A short length of Antonine Wall Ditch is visible between Polmont Church and the M9 motorway, located in the churchyard.

HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

The hollow of the ditch can be seen in the churchyard. Observations made during the extension of the churchyard in 1912-13, along with small-scale excavations to the west, revealed the stone base of the Antonine Wall Rampart.
